Trips are a privilege, in addition to Prom, we have other events scheduled for the remainder of the school year. We continue to celebrate your child's accomplishments. Please read below and review with your child the standards to which he/she/they must follow at all times to be chosen for any planned activities. The 12th grade Committee will review all student's conduct, grades, attendance and uniform adherence to make sure that all criteria are being met.

The following incentive trips are selected by the Senior Teacher Committee: permission slips will be given to those students who are eligible.

- 1- Hershey Park- June 6th & 7th. 2 day-1 night trip that includes lodging, food and all activities. Students will be in groups of 4 for room assignments. Students will be provided a permission slip as selected by the Senior Teacher Committee. A deposit of \$50 is required to reserve your spot; this money will be returned to the student when they attend the event.
- 2- Six Flags Great Adventure- Senior Night Friday June 9th- Open to all senior students! This trip will leave CVSR at approximately 1pm and will not return to CVSR until approximately 2am. A deposit of \$20 is required to reserve your spot; this money will be returned to the student when they attend the event.

Once the permission slips are given out they must also be returned along with the deposit for your child to be considered for each trip. The 12th grade committee will make all final decisions prior to the event.
