The Senior Prom will be held at Russo's On the Bay in Howard Beach on **Thursday, June 5th, 2025 from 6:30 pm to 11:30pm**. The cost of prom includes cocktail hour (no alcoholic beverages), soda, coffee, tea, dinner, and dessert, DJ, prom favors and balloon centerpieces for the tables.

Prom Tickets: \$140 per ticket- Only two tickets per student.

1st Payment must be made on **April 4th - \$70**

2nd Payment must be made on **May 5th - \$70**

Students must reserve a spot- seats are limited, payment cannot be taken on the day of Prom.
